About PDI-Kintha

The Peace and Development Initiative – Kintha (PDI-Kintha) was founded in 2013 in response to outbreaks of communal violence in 2012 and the more organized anti-Muslim violence that followed. Initial projects and activities sought to address the deepening religious and ethnic divisions that followed.

Early on, we focused much of our energy on building trust not only between communities affected by conflict, but also between community members and our staff. Through sports, music, and art activities we sought to transform attitudes driving conflict, raise awareness of issues underlying the conflict, and build skills to transform conflict.

We work with conflict-affected populations from central and northern areas of Rakhine State; however, following military clearance operations in August 2017 that lead to an exodus of over 600,000 people to Bangladesh and the subsequent barriers to access, we were forced to adjust the geographic focus area of some of our projects. We currently have 45 staff members implementing peacebuilding, education, and social cohesion activities in Sittwe, Buthidaung, Kyauk Taw, and Mrauk_Oo townships (of central and northern areas of Rakhine State) as of January 2019.

Activity Summary

This activity will support one research papers in Rakhine State. The research assesses the language barriers faced by the different communities in Rakhine to access services and service delivery provided by different stakeholders. The research/study will include a desk review and field research tentatively in the following locations: Sittwe, Thandwe and Buthidaung, Rakhine State; areas of long-standing ethnic and religious conflict. A team of local and international researchers will conduct this research and produce case study reports both in Burmese and English, resulting in accessible analysis to provide national and international actors with a set of case studies and guidelines on how to better understand, design, and implement effective programming in Rakhine State.

The anticipated activity outcomes of the Research Project are:

- 1) There will be enhanced understanding of language barriers affecting the design, planning and implementation of programs targeting the communities in conflict in Rakhine State.
- 2) Kintha PDI staff will have improved research and analysis skills and knowledge

Activity Justification

By conducting these conflict assessments on language barriers in Rakhine State, key stakeholders will be more informed and capable of identifying and designing better programming to further respond to the communities' needs. It is assumed that the limited understanding of diverse local perspectives is a critical impediment to designing contextually appropriate social cohesion and conflict prevention programming in Rakhine State.

Main Responsibilities:

PDI-Kintha invites application for dynamic, competent, hardworking, highly qualified and committed candidates for the position of "Researcher" willing to take up challenges for the project "Enhanced Understanding of Stakeholders Social Dynamics in Rakhine State". Researcher/Consultant is responsible to conduct one/two days training workshop in research methodology, mentor 4/5 PDI-Kintha researchers during the data collection process and lead in producing the research paper. Below is a breakdown of their duties and responsibilities.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Provide overall leadership and management of the Project and supervise the project officer and researchers
- Work closely with Director, Program Manager and other research associates for research planning and implementation
- Lead research survey and data collection (questionnaires, selection of variables, etc.) in field
- Lead in data analysis and survey review
- Maintain accurate records of interviews, focused group discussion, and safeguarding the confidentiality of subjects as necessary
- Maintain records and databases of activities to submit all evaluations to the Director and Program Manager when completed
- Lead in proofreading and producing the research paper
- Submit draft and final the inception report and the research paper to Director, Program Manager, and Administration Coordinator of PDI-Kintha

Skills and competencies requirements

The candidate should have the following skills and competencies.

- Master degree or higher is required
- At least 2 years of leading donor reporting and working experience in research project management
- Proven computer skills (MS Word, Excel, PowerPoint)

- Strong interpersonal communication skills and proven problem-solving and negotiation skills
- Willingness and ability to travel to project sites if necessary

- Excellent English language skills, with Myanmar or other relevant language skills highly valued
- Respect for the culture and lifestyles of the target groups
- Strong passion and commitment for the values, vision and mission of PDI-Kintha
- Able to work with diverse ethnic and religious groups
- Willingness to work overtime as the situation demands
- Interviewing and data collection skills
- Computer data entry skills
